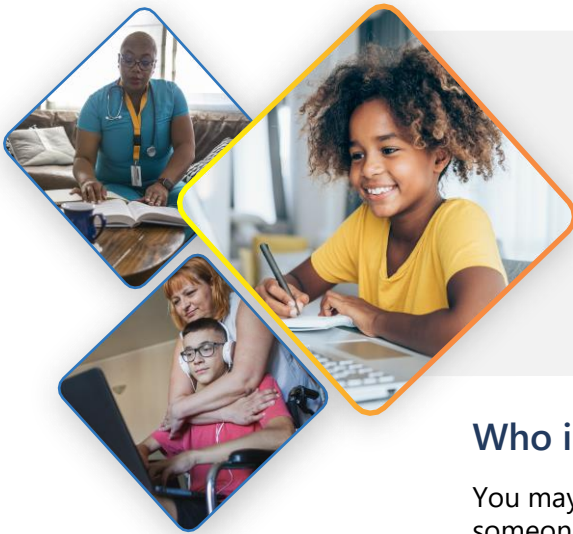

Who is eligible for low or no-cost internet?

You may be eligible if you live in a qualifying household, or if someone in your household receives a government benefit such as:

- SNAP (food stamps)
- Free or reduced lunch
- Medicaid
- Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
- Received a Federal Pell Grant in the current award year

Make sure to bring a photo ID and proof of enrollment in one of the above programs.

The Affordable Connectivity Program is a U.S. government program run by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to help income-insecure households pay for internet service and connected devices like a laptop or tablet.
