- Political support helped win strikes at Verizon, AT&T Southeast, and elsewhere.
- CWA led a coalition to defeat the anti-worker Trans-Pacific Partnership.
- Political action enabled Medicare to negotiate drug prices, saving seniors \$800 annually.
- Legislation passed to build high-speed internet nationwide with strong labor protections for union jobs.

I am making a contribution to a joint fundraising effort sponsored by CWA PAF and the AFL-CIO COPE PCC, and they may use my contributions for political purposes, including, but not limited to, the making of contributions to or expenditures on behalf of candidates for federal, state, and local offices and addressing political issues of public importance. Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and the name of the employer of individuals whose contributions exceed \$200 in a calendar year. Contributions or gifts to CWA PAF and AFL-CIO COPE PCC are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes.
