Phone Credits for Health Care Workers to Communicate with Clients

Communication from health workers can play a critical role in ensuring clients continue to receive necessary health care and treatment. This follow up can help ensure that clients know and can access the services they need to stay on treatment, receive psychosocial support, or receive support throughout pregnancy.

Materials for an HIV Test for One Infant

This test, when given to an infant soon after birth, can ensure a baby born with HIV can be put on a lifesaving treatment plan before they leave the clinic – a process that used to take up to several weeks. This work brings the test and results directly to the baby and mother, ensuring they receive the vital care they need, when they need it.
